The new graphic liner is any of these and more: thin, thick, shadowed, stacked, colored, sky liner, tri-liner, smudged and floating. No need to worry about the perfect line because there are no mistakes. Add a **pop of color** or two, smudge it, blend it, add white into the inner corners to open the eye... anything goes! Just make sure you are wearing liner this season.

- $\frac{1}{4}$ t Gold Frost
- $\frac{1}{4}$ t Onyx

CAKE EYELINER

lush black

ECSTASY BLUSH

light rose shimmer

ADRIFT

- $\frac{3}{4}$ t Translucent
- $\frac{1}{2}$ t Alexandrite
- $\frac{1}{8}$ + $\frac{1}{4}$ t Tourmaline
- $\frac{1}{8}$ t Amber
- 2 tiny Saturated Red

HUSH

light nude with soft shimmer

DESIRE

- Crème Base
- .125+.125 Mahogany +1 drop
- .50 Peach
- .125 Coral
- .125 Ochre
- .125 Cocoa
- 2 tiny Coral Frost
- 4 tiny Champagne Frost
- 3 tiny Crystal Frost
- 6 drops Silkening Modifier

REGENT PARK

- $\frac{3}{4}$ t Alabaster
- $\frac{1}{4}$ t Lapis
- $\frac{1}{8}$ t Tourmaline
- $\frac{1}{8}$ t Fuchsia Frost
- $\frac{1}{8}$ t Opal Frost
- $\frac{1}{8}$ t Crystal Frost

EXPOSED

light nude with soft shimmer

WINK

periwinkle shimmer

TO ACHIEVE THIS LOOK, start by lining your upper lash line with a black cake liner. Then, extend the liner outwards to create a wing. Next, use your eyeliner to create a perfectly cut crease above the crease of your lid.
